I may recommend you the official [Domain Tools Certification](#). Their certification includes a professional valuation and a trademark infringement verification. I don't know other domain certification services that provide this option. This service can be ordered by a domain owner only because they verify the owner's address. So your client should ask the seller to order this. Their valuations are reasonable. They are based on a quality of a domain name and a current market prices. It's not necessary to have a web site to get a good certification/valuation. They evaluate names in all languages and have many good reviews. [Domain Tools Certification](#) charges from 9 to 79 euros per certificate (depends on quantity of domains in one order). The more domains you submit in one order the more you save (per domain).

You may also list your domains for sale in [Domain Tools Auctions](#). For example, <http://www.escrow.com> will charge you 5-10% fee. [Domain Tools Auctions](#) will help you for free with transfer, payment etc. So if you sell your domain for 500 usd or more it's better to use [Domain Tools Auctions](#). If you sell a domain for 500 usd or less it's better to use <http://www.escrow.com>.
